Know Before You Go...

As we get ready to welcome the world's best athletics and showcase beautiful British Columbia, here are a few tips to enhance your spectator experience at the 2010 Olympics:

1. City Venues: Gates open two hours before the start of competition.
2. Mountain venues: Gates open three hours before the start of competition at Whistler and Cypress Mountain venues.
3. Opening and Closing Ceremonies: Gates open four hours early.
4. Check tickets: Make sure your ticket has the correct session code. (Treat your tickets like cash. Lost or stolen tickets cannot be replaced or refunded.)
5. Bring the smallest bag possible or no bag at all so you can use the express lane to enter the venue.
6. Be prepared: All spectators will be asked to pass through a metal detector and empty pockets of all metal objects.
7. Have fun and cheer loud for Team Canada!
